# Points of Note to all competitors in National ICA Competitions:



- 1. The National ICA Competitions are open to ICA members only.
- 2. A paid-up member for the purpose of entering the competition is a member for which current membership fee has been received and recorded in the Central Register of members at the Registered Office of the Association.
- 3. The National Contests Committee reserves the right to confirm membership status for entrants.
- 3. Please adhere strictly to the criteria of each specific competition.
- 4. There must be at least two entries in any competition for it to be held.
- 5. Judges' decisions are final in all competitions.
- 6. No late entries will be accepted.
- 7. From 2020 onwards, 1st Prize in any competition will only be awarded to the same entrant/team for two consecutive years. Having enjoyed 1st Prize for two consecutive years, the winning entrant/team will not be allowed participate in this competition again for a period of one year.
- 8. All Cups, Plaques, Shields and Trophies must be returned to the ICA National Contests Committee one month prior to that competition being run again or at an event in the first half of 2024 (if any).
- 9. Names and photographs of competition entrants/winners/audiences may be posted on our website www.ica.ie and on our Facebook page "ICA National Competitions". If you do not want your name/photograph posted to those sites, please indicate this clearly to the Competitions Committee on your entry or at competition events.
- 10. Entering any of the National ICA Competitions is deemed acceptance of the terms of entry, points of note and the rules as directed by the ICA National Contests Committee.

The National Contests Committee wish to thank all ICA members who took part in the 2023 National Competitions, and we also look forward to great participation in our 2024 programme.

We would also like to thank the Manager and all the staff in An Grianán for their cooperation in running Contests Weekend and the staff in Central Office for their contribution in proofing and printing.

Entries for 2023 Competitions greatly increased in some areas eg. Eleanora Cup for Drama saw a record entry. We hope that this trend will continue for 2024.


